### Notice of Regatta and Sailing Instructions Amendment 1

#### Addition of 2.5

- 2.5. All boats participating must have a minimum of three clearly visible and working navigational lights, namely port and starboard lights on the bow and white stern light, or a tri-colour on the mast. These lights must be switched on from dusk till dawn, and visible from a minimum distance of 1 nautical mile, or the boat will be recorded as DSQ in the final results.

#### Change of 5.3

- 5.3. Registration will be up to 08h00 on Race Day. Late entries shall be accepted on the water.

#### Shall now read as:

- 5.3. Registration will be up to 11h00 on Race Day. Late entries shall be accepted on the water

#### Change of 6.4

- 6.4. Race will be scored winner Lap 1, Winner Lap 2, and 100 Miler Winner Overall

#### Shall now read as:

- 6.4. Race will be scored winner Lap 1, Winner Lap 2, Winner Lap 3, Winner Lap 4, and 100 Miler Winner Overall.

#### Addition of 6.6

- 6.6. A WhatsApp link will be created between the Race Officer and each race entrant, based on the mobile number used during registration. A Google location pin is to be sent to the Race Officer's mobile number at the rounding of each mark. The Race Officer's mobile number is 0836130033. This information will be used both for safety reasons as well as possible leg time recording as well as to ensure all marks are reached during the race.

#### Change of 16.2

- 16.2. Any yacht not finishing before 09h00 on Sunday the 29<sup>th</sup> October 2017 will be deemed not to have finished only the remaining legs/laps.
