# NOTICE OF RACE

#### 1 RULES

**1.1** The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

**1.2** The SA Sailing prescriptions for National and Regional Championships will not apply.

#### 2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be posted on 5 December 2024, at LDYC Notice Board for all classes as well as on the LDYC website.

### 3 COMMUNICATION

- **3.1** The online official notice board is located at LDYC as well as on the official WhatsApp group.
- **3.2** All boats may carry a marine VHF radio capable of communicating on 9 and 16. Official race channel shall be 9.

## 4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- **4.1** The regatta is open to all sailing boats.
- **4.2** Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form and submitting it, together with the fee, to **LDYC** by **26th December 2024**, registering online at <a href="https://www.windsail.co.za">www.windsail.co.za</a>.
- **4.3** To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.
- 4.4 Late entries will be accepted under the following conditions: 31st December 2024 by 12:00 latest
- **4.5** All competitors need not be members in good standing of SA Sailing and of a yacht club affiliated to and in good standing with SA Sailing (or their equivalent in the case of non-South Africans) and legally permitted to compete.

Boats may display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority.

#### 7 SCHEDULE

- **7.1** Dates of racing: **1 January 2025**
- **7.2** The scheduled time of the warning signal for the race is **08:55am**.
- **7.3** A maximum of one race is scheduled.

#### 8 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows: **Based on the entries received** and included in the annual Round the Island prize giving.

## 9 RISK STATEMENT

RRS 3 states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone." Competitors participate in this event entirely at their own risk. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

## **10 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of **R20,000** per incident or the equivalent.
